ENGLISH WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION SOUTH EASTERN CHAMPIONSHIP AT CHIPPING NORTON GOLF CLUB, OXON, 15TH – 17TH JULY 2008

The Championship shall consist of a 36 hole qualifying round: the leading 16 scratch scores to compete in the matchplay stages. All ties shall be decided on the last 18 holes; if a further tie results, on the last 9,6,3 or 1. The winner will receive the Doris Chambers Cup and voucher: the runner-up the Ashcombe Challenge Salver and voucher. The South East ELGA Intermediate Trophy will also be awarded to the winning competitor in the Intermediate age group (between 18 & 23 on 1st January 2008) – please signify on entry slip.

The County Shield – each county shall nominate four players to represent it in the County Shield. From these four, the three lowest aggregate scratch scores returned over the 36 holes medal round shall count. The nominated players must be members of that County Association in the (previous) S.E. Division.

QUALIFICATIONS

Open to any Amateur with a handicap of 9 or lower and must be a member of a County Association or of a Club affiliated to the (previous) South East Division.
